Timetables

- Individual timetables have been checked and balanced (where possible)
- Course changes can be requested using the *Course Change Form* posted on our website. We will look at requests this week but due to the system being rolled over in the summer, most changes will not take place until late August.
 - Requests are prioritized by need for diploma requirements, need for post secondary requirements and then in the order in which we received the request.
- Grade 12 students can take 2 spares this year. However they can request to take more courses, if they so desire.
- Students who requested CALM can take it a number of ways
 - In-class for half a semester, paired with the following:
 - CALM/Psychology
 - PE 20/CALM
 - PE 10/CALM
 - If "in-class" options do not fit into a student's timetable it can be taken in SDL (Self-Directed Learning):
 - During a scheduled block--students who requested CALM but do not see it in their timetable, check to see if an SDL block was selected for you to take it in
 - If it does not fit in a student's grade 11 timetable, it can be taken
 - In 2020 Summer School
 - In grade 12
- Unfortunately some high school sections could not run due to low requests
 - Choir--will now be an after-school option for credits, similar to Advanced
 Acting/Technical Theatre credits run for Mad Duck Theatre productions
 - Sports Performance, Film Appreciation and Leadership
 - Firefighting (we would like to run this program in alternating years)
- Note we are considering a new Tutorial format so just be advised that it might not be at the end of the day next year

- School Photos are done for grade 10-12 this day so wear your favorite shirt!




WELCOME TO OUR NEW TEACHERS




School Cash
